

Bursary Information and terms and conditions

*Bursary applications must be submitted **3 months** before your trip to Ufton Court.*

Where the grants come from

Our bursaries are funded through donations. We believe everyone should be able to have the opportunity to access the educational activities available at Ufton Court.

How much can be requested?

We believe that every child who wants to visit Ufton Court as part of their school's visit should be able to and that a lack of parental income should not be a barrier.

Ufton Court will award bursaries of between 25 and 50% of the overnight costs of a residential visit and will consider bursaries for day visits as well. If the visiting school are willing to fund 25% of the cost of the visit we will award a further 25% bursary increasing our award to 75% and making the visit free of charge to families.

We are unable to provide bursaries for trips between April-July inclusive.

Application process

Schools must complete a Bursary application form for each child to be considered which can be found on our website under the 'About us' tab and email this to our office.

We award bursaries to children in receipt of Pupil Premium, Free School meals, who are young carers or are looked after children.

We will consider awarding bursaries to children who are twins or triplets if the burden of a visit for more than one child is too much for parents.

Completed applications are accepted throughout the year, but we are unable to offer bursaries to schools visiting between April-July inclusive.

Evidence to support application

We reserve the right to request evidence from the school or the family that they are eligible to receive a bursary.
